

Minnesota's Private Colleges: Earning Credit in High School

There are opportunities for high school students to earn college credit that will be recognized when they enroll at any of our 17 nonprofit institutions. Here is a summary of what individual colleges recognize and accept when first-year students have participated in Advanced Placement (AP), concurrent enrollment, College-Level Examination Program (CLEP), International Baccalaureate (IB) and Post-secondary Enrollment Options (PSEO).
